Dear Parent,

Further to my letter dated 18th January, I can confirm that the next day of planned industrial action is **Wednesday 1st March**, followed by two further days on **Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March**.

After reviewing the risk assessment, I have decided to **open** the school to the following groups:

- **Vulnerable pupils** as defined by the relevant DfE guidance. *If your child falls into this category, you will have already been contacted by the Academy.*
- **Year 11 pupils.**

For pupils **not** attending school, appropriate work will be provided online via **MS Teams**.

Accessing MS Teams

- Go to <https://office.com>
- Click on 'sign in'.
- Click on 'work or school account'.
- Enter your username i.e. school e-mail address XXXX@eastwood.southend.sch.uk
- Enter your password (the same password as the one used to access your school account).
- Click on the 'MS Teams' icon from the Office 365 applications on the left-hand side.
- Click on the 'Teams' icon from the MS Teams applications on the left-hand side.
- Follow your school timetable period 1-5 and access work by clicking on either the **Class Team e.g. 22/23-10y-Cz2** or **Year Group Team e.g. 22/23-Year 10**
- Click on 'Files' 'Posts' and/or 'Assignments' to access the work for the lesson.
